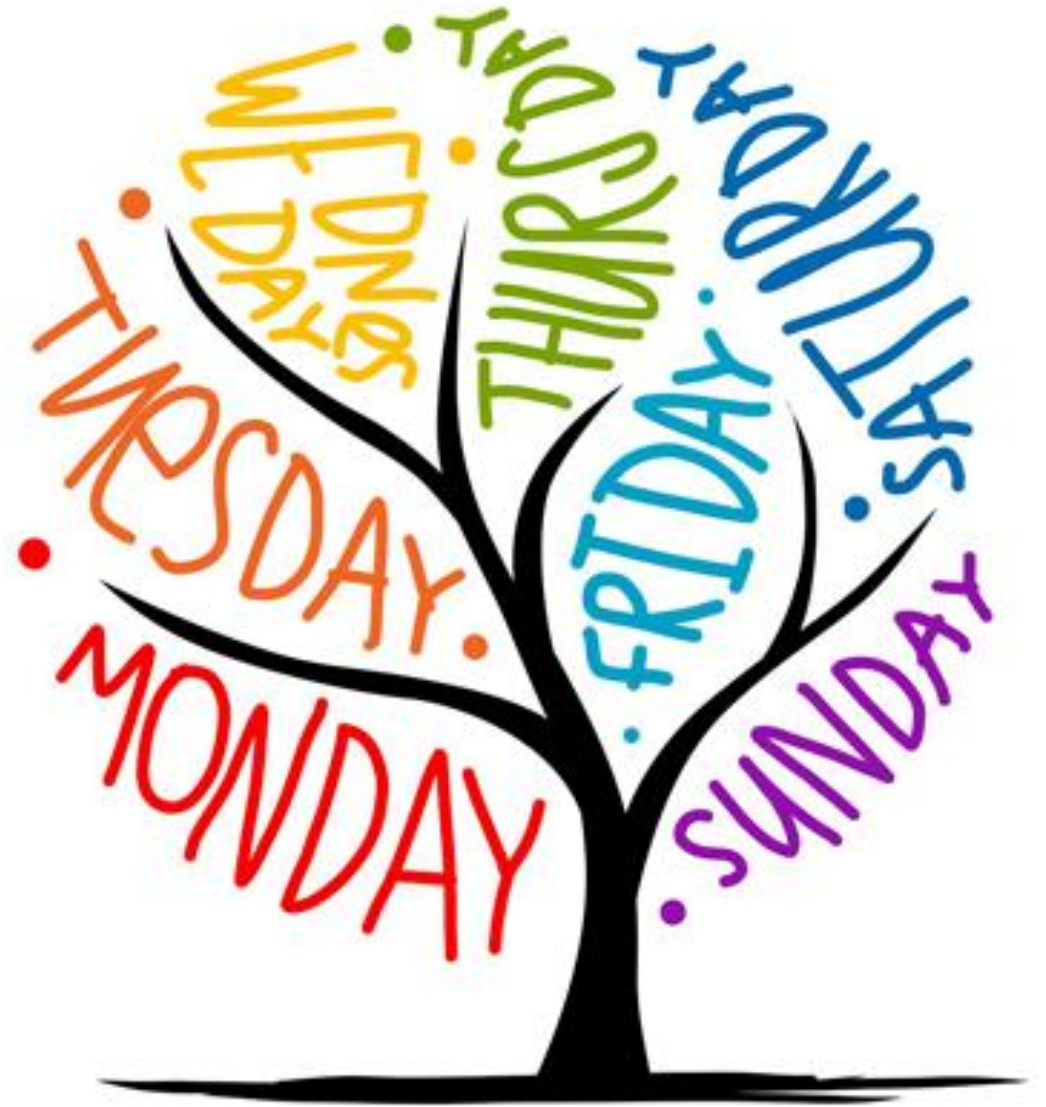

# Timetable Routines

- Children can enter school and remain on the playground. School day starts at 08:45. Staff are available to supervise on the yard.
- Each day the children complete a Maths lesson, English Lesson and Guided Read.
- Throughout the week children will complete Science and a variety of foundation lessons. (Computing, PE, DT, History, Geog)
- Whole school assembly takes place on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.
- School finishes at 3:15pm.





# Daily Routines

- Every morning children start their day by completing a vocabulary task, whilst the morning register is taken.
- Children have a line order to ensure they have a settled day moving around school.
- Children have their own lockers and lunch bag/box station. They can utilise as and when needed.
- If a home reading book needs changing then it is the responsibility of Year 6 child to bring their home reading book in to change. The adult does not need to sign home reading books.

# How we sanction unacceptable behaviour:

The school may use one or more of the following sanctions in response to unacceptable behaviour:

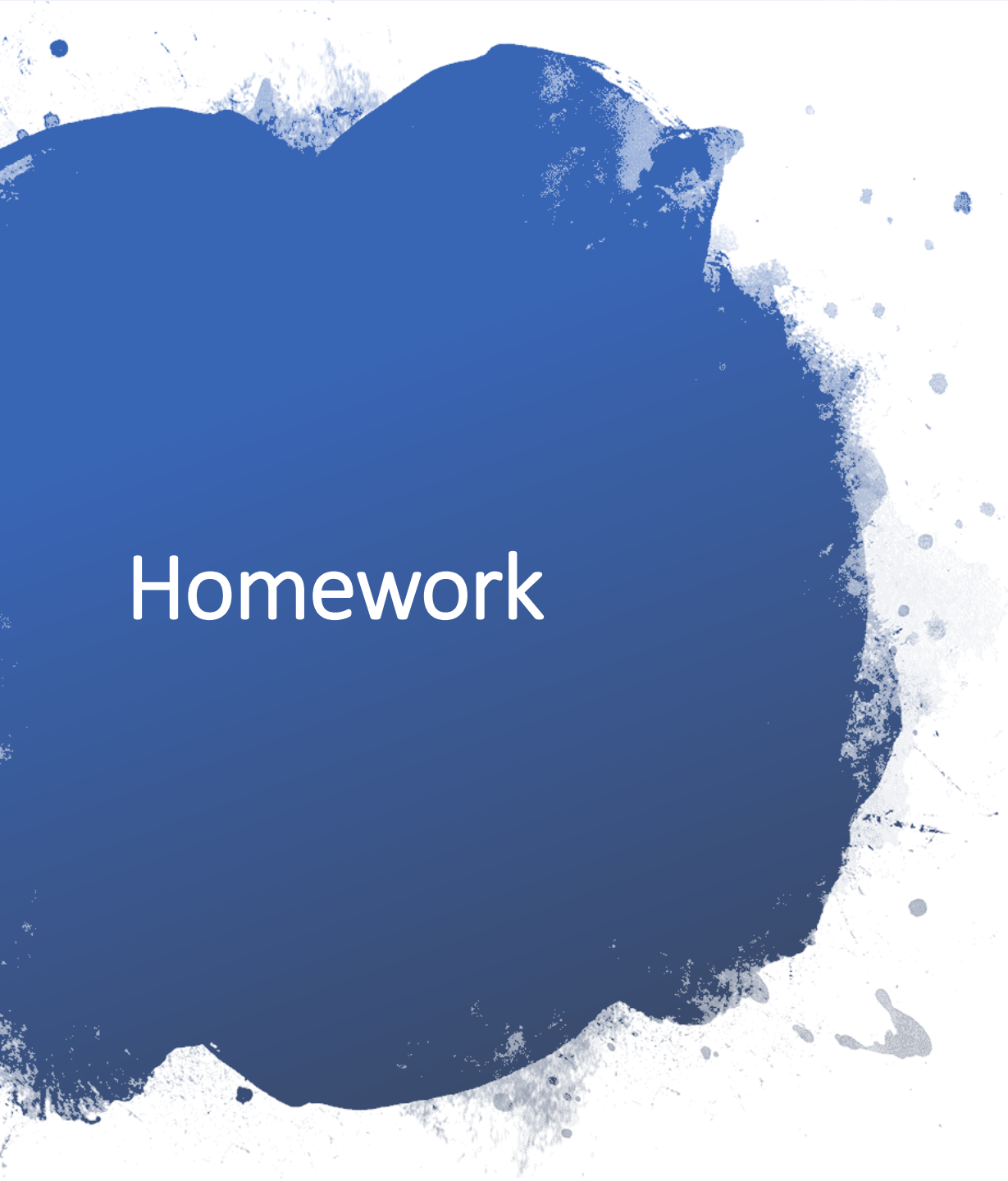
- A verbal reminder.
- Children have a maximum of two reminders.
- Sending the pupil out of the class for 5 minutes refocus time. ( third reminder)
- Loss of playtime to complete work supervised by class teacher (if needed).
- Referring the pupil to a senior member of staff for 10 minutes refocus time (fourth reminder) followed by 15 minutes reflection time at break or lunchtime with SLT.
- Referring the pupil to the Headteacher (fifth reminder) for 20 minutes refocus time followed by a loss of playtime/lunchtime/after school club activity supervised by the DHT/HT.
- Letters or phone calls home to parents.
- Agreeing a behaviour contract and use of a daily/weekly behaviour chart.
- Every teacher/ teaching assistant records behaviour concerns electronically using CPOMS. Incidents are reviewed by SLT to monitor behaviour of pupils who persistently show inappropriate behaviour.

# HOW WE PROMOTE GOOD BEHAVIOUR

We praise and reward children for good behaviour in a variety of ways



- develop good relationships with children and build self-esteem;
  - congratulate and praise children;
  - make clear our expectations of good behaviour.
- discourage unsociable behaviour by promoting mutual respect.
- encourage children to take responsibility for their own actions and behaviour through Restorative Practice strategies.
  - model example standards of behaviour.
    - Praise assembly weekly
    - Certificates
    - Golden book
    - Class Gold stars



# Homework

All homework is set on **Friday** and should be brought back the following Friday.

Homework set will be Reading, Spelling, Reading Plus and Sumdog. SATs booklets will also be issued after October half term. If children do not bring back their homework they will need a note from their grown-up to explain why or they can complete it at lunch time. We will have homework club running every Friday during indoor lunchtime. Children will also have the opportunity throughout the week if needed (during their scheduled indoor lunch).



# Home Reading

Children should read at least 3 times a week. This needs to be written in their planners with the date and page number and a small comment of likes/dislikes.

Reading records are checked every Friday and if a child has not met the minimum expectation for reading they will attend catch up reading club on a Friday break-time.



P.E

Indoor Kit - Shorts, T shirt, Pumps. PE kit should be taken home half termly.

P.E this term will be focusing on swimming, therefore children only need their swimming kits.

Uniform to be worn on P.E days.



# Water Bottles

Children are asked to bring in their own water bottle so they can keep hydrated throughout the day.

Water only please, not juice.
